



2018 Savigny les Beaune Les Saucours Chardonnay

Chandon de Briailles sku BC 59111

Located in the village of Savigny les Beaune, Domaine Chandon de Briailles has been in the same family since 1834. It belongs to the Count and Countess Aymard-Claude de Nicolay and heir children. François de Nicolay and his sister Claude de Nicolay are currently responsible for running the 34 acres biodynamic Estate (organic since 1995, biodynamic since 2005) spread across the appellations of Savigny, Pernand and Aloxe. They are the largest landholder of Ile-des-Vergelesses, and the only domaine to grow both chardonnay and pinot noir there. Annual production is approx. 50,000 allocated bottles. Domaine Chandon de Briailles is part of the association of Les Domaines Familiaux de Tradition; 28 of the most prestigious domaines in Burgundy.

100% Young chardonnay vines - 13.5% alc.

This climat is located south of Savigny les Beaune, at the southern exit of the village in the direction of Beaune. Mid slope, east facing, refreshed by the light winds that come from the Savigny valley, with white marl soil, perfect for chardonnay.

The fresh, quite delicate bouquet features dried honey, jasmine and light honeysuckle aromas. The palate is very well balanced and fresh, the acidity nicely judged, and veins of lemongrass enliven the poised finish.
